Supplemental Final Bond Resolution for Georgia Tech Athletic Association ("GTAA"): Mr. Glenn Thomson of Alston & Bird LLP and Mr. Mark Rountree and Ms. Tanesha Steward of the Georgia Institute of Technology ("Georgia Tech") appeared in connection with the request for a supplemental final bond resolution for the issuance of (i) \$32,065,000 in revenue bonds for a federally tax-exempt transaction to finance the costs of renovating and improving the football and basketball stadiums located on the Georgia Tech campus, refund a portion of the outstanding Series 2012A Bonds, pay capitalized interest during construction, and pay costs of issuance; and (ii) \$131,575,000 in revenue bonds for a federally taxable transaction to finance the costs of renovating the baseball stadium located on the Georgia Tech campus, refund all or a portion of the Series 2011 Bonds and a portion of the Series 2012A Bonds, pay capitalize interest during construction, and pay costs of issuance. Upon a motion made by Mr. Broadbent, which was seconded by Mr. Beach, the Authority unanimously approved the supplemental final bond resolution for GTAA.
