OLD BUSINESS:

Assignment of Buckhead Atlanta Development LLC Residential and Retail Projects (the "Buckhead Atlanta Development Projects") to 3005 Peachtree NE Owner, LLC ("3005 Peachtree"). Ms. Caroline Loftin of King & Spalding LLP and Mr. Naheem Harris of Vinson & Elkins LLP appeared in connection

with the request to approve an assignment of the Buckhead Atlanta Development Projects to 3005 Peachtree. More specific details are described in the Fact Sheet included as part of this item posted on the Authority's website. Upon a motion made by Mr. Lamont, which was seconded by Mr. Beach, the Authority unanimously approved the assignment to 3005 Peachtree.

Final Bond Resolution for I-285 Industrial Properties, LLC (Induced as Johnson Development Associates, Inc.) ("I-285 Industrial"). Mr. Ben Brooks of Smith, Gambrell & Russell LLP, and Mr. Andy Halligan of Johnson Development Associates, Inc. appeared in connection with the request for a final bond resolution for the issuance of \$13,600,000 in taxable revenue bonds for the development of an approximately 250,000 square foot, Class A industrial facility that would be speculatively built for an end user in the logistics, e-commerce, distribution, warehousing or light manufacturing industries to be located near the intersection of Donald Lee Hollowell Parkway and Fulton Industrial Boulevard in the City of Atlanta. More specific details are described in the Fact Sheet included as part of this item posted on the Authority's website. Upon a motion made by Mr. Lamont, which was seconded by Mr. Broadbent, the Authority approved, with the exception of Mr. Bacote abstaining, the final bond resolution for I-285 Industrial.

NEW BUSINESS:

Letter of Inducement for SCP Hapeville Owner, LLC ("SCP Hapeville"). Ms. Allison Dyer and Mr. Woody Vaughan of Holland & Knight LLP and Mr. Will Casaday of South City Partners appeared in connection with the request to approve a letter of inducement for the issuance of \$53,403,000 in taxable revenue bonds for the development of an approximately 284-unit mixed-use apartment community with approximately 5,000 square feet of retail space, 24 rental townhomes and 20,000 square feet of office space to be located at 397 North Central Avenue in the City of Hapeville. More specific details are described in the Fact Sheet included as part of this item posted on the Authority's website. Upon a motion made by Mr. Broadbent, which was seconded by Mr. Lamont, the Authority unanimously approved the letter of inducement for SCP Hapeville.
