The Development Authority of Fulton County (“DAFC”) has recently announced its new Strategic Initiative Community Grant program.

Organizations which serve Fulton County residents may apply for grant funding up to \$500,000. Applications are currently available online located at the top of the homepage of the DAFC website at www.developfultoncounty.com (the “Application”). Awards will be considered for organizations focusing on at least one of the following four key focus areas: housing, jobs and workforce, small business growth and education. Funds may only be used for programmatic purposes and may not be used for operations, salaries or overhead. Additional qualifications and requirements are included in the Application.

DAFC is among the preeminent development authorities in the southeastern United States. It has issued more than \$25 billion in bonds and has helped businesses and institutions build, renovate, expand and/or relocate in Fulton County, Georgia.

Applications will be accepted beginning August 1, 2022 until September 28, 2022 and evaluated according to the rules and regulations of the Strategic Initiative Committee and the DAFC’s board of directors.
